

Amendment to SB 337-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

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3 1 Home Education; Notification. Amend RSA 193-A:5, I to read as follows:

4 I.(a) Any parent commencing a home education program for a child, for a child who
5 withdraws from a public school, or for a child who moves into a school district shall notify the
6 commissioner of education, resident district superintendent, or principal of a nonpublic school ~~of~~
7 ~~such within 30 days~~ **prior to commencement of such program.**

8 **(b) Any parent planning to continue a home education program under**
9 **subparagraph I(a) shall notify the commissioner of education, resident district**
10 **superintendent, or principal of a nonpublic school within 30 days of the anniversary of**
11 **commencement of the home education program or by the first school day according to the**
12 **school calendar in the child's resident school district.**

13 2 New Paragraph; Home Education; Notification. Amend RSA 193-A:5 by inserting after
14 paragraph IV the following new paragraph:

15 V. Prior to the initial year of a home education program, a parent shall provide to the
16 department of education, resident district superintendent, or principal of a nonpublic school,
17 information which summarizes planned and supervised instructional and related activities,
18 including a draft curriculum demonstrating instruction in science, mathematics, language,
19 government, history, health, reading, writing, spelling, the history of the constitutions of New
20 Hampshire and the United States, and an exposure to and appreciation of art and music.

21 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill makes various changes to the notification requirements for parents involved in a home education program.
